Groundbreaking for Churchwell Drive Reconstruction

PANAMA CITY BEACH, FL (April 10, 2007)-The groundbreaking ceremony for the first Front Beach Road Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) project will take place on Wednesday, April 11, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. at the corner of Front Beach Road and Churchwell Drive.

The Churchwell Drive Reconstruction project will widen the existing roadway, provide pedestrian sidewalks and bicycle lanes, relocate overhead utilities underground and replace the existing bridge. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is providing the funding for the new bridge which includes a walkway for pedestrians as well as bicycle lanes. The improvements to this corridor will allow for more efficient transit between Front Beach and Middle Beach Roads and will increase safety for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.

The cost of the project is approximately \$6,750,000 which includes the FDOT funded bridge.

The contractor, Marshall Brothers Industrial, is scheduled to complete the project by summer, 2008.
