

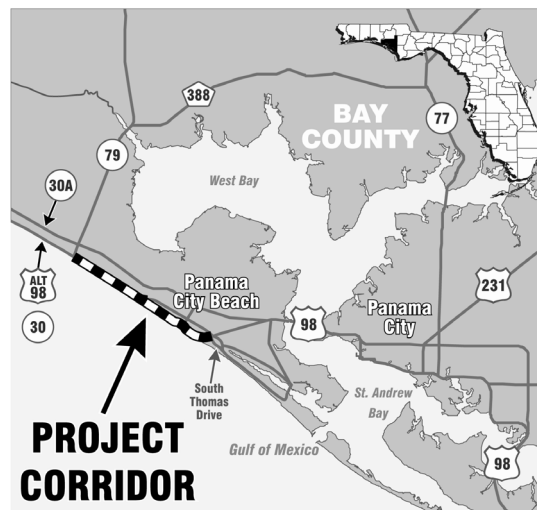
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for Improvements to Front Beach Road (SR 30/US 98A) in Panama City Beach

Bay County, Florida

The City of Panama City Beach invites the public to participate in a Public Hearing for the proposed improvements to Front Beach Road (SR 30/US 98A) from SR 79 to its intersection with Hutchison Boulevard (SR 392A) and North Thomas Drive. **The Public Hearing will be held July 20, 2010 at the Panama City Beach Senior Center, located at 423 Lyndell Lane in Panama City Beach. The meeting will begin at 6 p.m. with an open-house, followed by a presentation and opportunity for public comment from 6:30 – 7:30 p.m.**

This Public Hearing is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements and in accordance with Federal Executive Orders 11990 and 11988. The proposed action involves reconstructing the roadway to provide access management measures, pedestrian and bicycle facilities, transit lanes with transit pullouts, turn lanes at major intersections, stormwater collection and retention, and aesthetic improvements such as landscaping, street lighting, and the relocation of utilities underground.



The draft project documents will be available for review in person Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. during the period of June 28 – July 30, 2010 (excluding July 5) at the new Panama City Beach Library (12500 Hutchison Boulevard, Panama City Beach, FL) and at the offices of DRMP (100 Richard Jackson Boulevard, Suite 120, Panama City Beach, FL). In addition, the documents will be available online at www.pcbonthemove.com. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits, in place of or in addition to oral statements, may do so at the Public Hearing or by sending them to Greg Vaughn, Public Involvement Coordinator, PBS&J, 2639 North Monroe Street, Building C, Tallahassee, FL 32303. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before July 30, 2010 will become part of the Public Hearing record.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status.
